August 3 – 7, 2019

Itinerary:

- Day 1:** Arrive in Washington, D.C. Evening tour of the city.
- Day 2:** Sightseeing in Washington, D. C., The White House, George Washington Monument, Abraham Lincoln Memorial, The Pentagon, Smithsonian Institute, Jefferson Memorial.
